“Thank You” Heart

Instructions


Materials:


- Thank You Heart template (see following slide)
- Red or pink construction paper (don't have any? don't worry!)
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Markers, colored pencils, crayons

Making your thank you heart:

1. Print the thank you heart from the following slide
2. Cut the thank you heart out
3. Cut a larger heart shape from red and pink construction paper to use as a mount (optional)
4. Glue thank you heart to construction paper mount (decorate it if you'd like!)
5. Hang heart on your front door, in windows, or any place else that can be seen by passersby!
